Eastern Redbud, Cercis canadensis (first seen in bloom). Woodland edges, 4/6/13 (Lisa Gould).

Flowering Dogwood, *Cornus florida* (first seen in bloom). Throughout county, 4/8/13 (Lisa Gould).

*Henbit, Lamium amplexicaule (in bloom). Ruderal, 3/21/13 to present (Lisa Gould).

*Purple Dead-nettle, *Lamium purpureum* (in bloom). Ruderal 3/21/13 to present (Lisa Gould).

Poor-man's Pepper, *Lepidium virginicum* (in bloom & fruit). Ruderal, 3/21/13 to present (Lisa Gould).

*Fragrant Honeysuckle, Lonicera fragrantissima (in bloom [4/7/13] passing] and fruit [some ripe 4/7/13]). Roadsides, 3/21/13 to present (L. Gould).

*Money-plant, Lunaria annua (first seen in bloom). Ruderal, 4/7/13 (Lisa Gould).

*Creeping Ladies-sorrel, *Oxalis corniculata* (in bloom). City yards, 4/3/13 to present (Lisa Gould).

*Indian Strawberry, *Potentilla indica* [= *Duchesne indica*] (in bloom). City yards, 3/21/13 to present (Lisa Gould).
