Please report only for the following counties: Alamance, Caswell, Davidson, Davie, Forsyth, Guilford, Montgomery, Randolph, Rockingham, Stokes, Surry, and Yadkin.

Please include only plants that are in the wild (native or naturalized)—no garden plants. Species with an asterisk (*) are not native to our area but have naturalized here.

Invasive species status [marked with an exclamation point and a number] is from the NC Native Plant Society's *Invasive Exotic Plants in NC* – 2010, which is available at http://www.ncwildflower.org/invasives/list.htm. The Society ranks invasive plants by the threat level: Rank 1 [!1] = Severe Threat, Rank 2 [!2] = Significant Threat, Rank 3 [!3] = Lesser Threat, Watch List A [!4] = naturalizing and may become a problem, Watch List B [!5] = known threat in other states but not yet a problem here. Common Wild Ginger, *Asarum canadense* (foliage). Wooded area off Cedar Trail Connector, Muddy Creek Greenway, 7/4/22 (Margaret Cobb).

Common Milkweed, *Asclepias syriaca* (in bloom and in fruit). Muddy Creek Greenway, edge of greenway trail, 7/4/22 and 7/24/22 (Margaret Cobb).

Butterflyweed, Asclepias tuberosa (in bloom). Roadsides, throughout month (Margaret Cobb).

Common Pawpaw, *Asimina triloba* (foliage). Wooded area off Cedar Trail Connector, Muddy Creek Greenway, 7/4/2022 (Margaret Cobb).

Southern Lady Fern, *Athyrium asplenioides* (foliage). Muddy Creek Greenway - Cedar Trail connector, wooded floodplain near brook, 7/4/2022 (Margaret Cobb).

False Nettle, *Boehmeria cylindrica* (foliage). Wooded area off Cedar Trail Connector, Muddy Creek Greenway, 7/4/2022 (Margaret Cobb).

Trumpet Creeper, *Campsis radicans* (in bloom). Muddy Creek Greenway, edge of greenway trail, 7/4/22 and 7/24/22 (Margaret Cobb). Roadside, 7/17/22 (Lisa Gould).

Low St. John's-wort, *Hypericum stragulum* (in bloom). Yard, throughout month (Lisa Gould).

***Spotted Cat's-ear**, *Hypochaeris radicata* (in bloom + fruit). Lawns and edges, throughout month (Lisa Gould).

Spotted Jewelweed, *Impatiens capensis* (in bud). Muddy Creek Greenway, throughout month (Margaret Cobb).

***Prickly Lettuce**, *Lactuca serriola* [= *Lactuca scariola*] (in bloom + fruit). Edges, 7/11/22 (Lisa Gould).

***Crape-myrtle**, *Lagerstroemia indica* (in bloom). Naturalized along a railroad track, 7/11/22 (Lisa Gould).

*[3] **Yellow Archangel**, *Lamium galeobdolon* [= *Lamiastrum galeobdolon*] (foliage). Muddy Creek Greenway - Cedar Trail connector, wooded floodplain near brook, 7/4/2022 (Margaret Cobb).

*Everlasting Pea, *Lathyrus latifolius* (in bloom + fruit). Edges, throughout month (Lisa Gould).

Cardinal Flower, *Lobelia cardinalis* (in bloom). Cedar Trail connector, Muddy Creek Greenway, 7/24/22 (Margaret Cobb).

Allegheny Monkey-flower, *Mimulus ringens* (in bloom). Cedar Trail Connector, Muddy Creek Greenway, 7/24/22 and 7/31/22 (Margaret Cobb).

Common Evening-primrose, *Oenothera biennis* (in bloom). Roadsides, throughout month (Lisa Gould).

Sensitive Fern, *Onoclea sensibilis* (foliage). Cedar Trail Connector, Muddy Creek Greenway, 7/4/22 (Margaret Cobb).

***Creeping Lady's-sorrel**, *Oxalis corniculata* (in bloom + fruit). Edges, throughout month (Lisa Gould).

Silky Dogwood, *Swida amomum* [= *Cornus amomum*] (in fruit). Muddy Creek Greenway, edge of greenway trail, 7/4/22 (Margaret Cobb).

***Common Dandelion**, *Taraxacum officinale* (in bloom + fruit). Lawns & edges, throughout month (Lisa Gould).

Common Germander, *Teucrium canadense* (in bloom). Muddy Creek Greenway, 7/4/22 (Margaret Cobb).

*White Clover, Trifolium repens (in bloom). Lawns & edges, throughout month (Lisa Gould).
