Triad Flora Report

November-December 2022

Here is the latest Triad Flora report. To contribute, send me an email (<u>lisalgould@gmail.com</u>) or text (336-837-9833) your observations, including common name, scientific name (if possible), place observed (locale, town, county), date observed, stage (e.g., in bloom, in fruit, leaves only, etc.), and observer's name. Please report only for the following counties: Alamance, Caswell, Davidson, Davie, Forsyth, Guilford, Montgomery, Randolph, Rockingham, Stokes, Surry, and Yadkin. You can send your data at any time; I like to receive observations for a month by **the 9**th of the following month. Please include only plants that are in the wild (native or naturalized)—no garden plants. Species with an asterisk (*) are not native to our area but have naturalized here.

Nomenclature is from *Flora of the Southeastern United States*, 2022, by Alan S. Weakley, UNC Herbarium, Chapel Hill NC. Available as a free download (a searchable pdf) from: https://ncbg.unc.edu/research/unc-herbarium/flora-request/

Invasive species status [marked with an exclamation point and a number] is from the NC Native Plant Society's *Invasive Exotic Plants in NC – 2010*, which is available at http://www.ncwildflower.org/invasives/list.htm. The Society ranks invasive plants by the threat level: Rank 1 [!1] = Severe Threat, Rank 2 [!2] = Significant Threat, Rank 3 [!3] = Lesser Threat, Watch List A [!4] = naturalizing and may become a problem, Watch List B [!5] = known threat in other states but not yet a problem here. This list is a work-in-progress—if you have comments, go to the web link for information on how to provide feedback.

*Indian-strawberry, *Potentilla indica* [= *Duchesnea indica*] (in bloom). Lawns & edges, 11/2/22 (Lisa Gould).

*[!2] **Jetbead**, *Rhodotypos scandens* (in fruit and naturalizing in the woods). Tanglewood Park, 11/5/22 (Lisa Gould).

*[!3] **Common Groundsel**, *Senecio vulgaris* (in bloom + fruit). Edges, throughout both months (Lisa Gould).

*[!2] Common Chickweed, *Stellaria media* (in bud). Edges, 12/13/22 (Lisa Gould). Black Walnut Bottoms, Bethania, 12/31/22 (Lisa Gould).

Starved Aster/Calico Aster, *Symphyotrichum lateriflorum* [= *Aster lateriflorus*] (in bloom). Bethabara woodland, 11/9/22 (Lisa Gould).

Hairy White Oldfield Aster/Frost Aster, *Symphyotrichum pilosum* [= *Aster pilosus*] (in bloom). Roadsides, 11/16/22 (Lisa Gould).

*Common Dandelion, *Taraxacum officinale* (in bloom + fruit). Yards and edges, throughout both months (Lisa Gould).

Cranefly Orchid, *Tipularia discolor* (fresh foliage). Tanglewood Park, 11/5/22 (Lisa Gould).

*White Clover, *Trifolium repens* (in bloom). Yards and edges, throughout November; last December date recorded 12/8/22 (Lisa Gould).

Common Wingstem, *Verbesina alternifolia* (in fruit). Tanglewood Park, 11/5/22 (Lisa Gould).

Southern Crownbeard, *Verbesina occidentalis* (in fruit). Tanglewood Park, 11/5/22 (Lisa Gould).

*[!2] Ivyleaf Speedwell, *Veronica hederifolia* (foliage). Lawn, 12/13/22 (Lisa Gould).
